

Tomogashima Islands Area 友ヶ島



Located inside the Setonaikai National Park, this hiking course is very popular as it leads hikers by ruins of Weapons Batteries from Japan's modern history and communities of wetland plants.

Kumano Kodo Pilgrimage Routes

These ancient roads connected Kyoto and Osaka with the Kumano Shrines. Their history goes way back so obviously there are many cultural properties and legends associated with them, plus a wondrous natural landscape.

This is one of the largest private residences in the Kii River Basin. The land and structures were typical of an official from the Wasa Clan of the Late Edo Period.

Kii-fudoki-no-oka Museum of
Archaeology and Folklore

This museum/park is a great place to experience what ancient life was like. The some 65 ha site includes the Iwasenzuka Tumulus, restored pit dwellings and old homes.

Shiki no Sato Park 四季の郷公園

This nature and agricultural park sits on a vast 25.5 ha site. There are playgrounds and flowers blooming through the year.

Three Saigoku Shrines

It is a time-honored practice and considered one of the more preeminent religious practices in Western Japan, to visit the Three Saigoku Shrines in a single trip. The shrines include the pair of Hinokumajingu and Kunikakusujingu (located on the same grounds), Kamayamajinja and Itakisojinja.

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
